- 50% of handicap used after tee differential adjustment (same as last year)
- 5 flights paying 1st, 2nd, 3rd places
- Championship Flight- Black Tees, 65+ White Tees
- All other Flights- White Tees, 65+ Gold Tees
- USGA rules apply except on hole #2 and #4 if you hit the ball in the maintenance area you may drop without penalty behind the trees on the back of #4 green (Drop Zone)
- Tee times on Saturday are posted in the pro shop
- Sunday will be a shotgun start at 10am
- Calcutta: \$200 per team (Please bring cash)
- \$1000 skins game per day (Saturday/Sunday) 2 Flights for skins game. (1 & 2) (3,4,5)
- 1st 2 flights there is no 7 stroke differential.



Hole-in-One Insurance

It cost you nothing to sign up for Hole-in-One Insurance.

How do you play?

You tell the proshop that you want to get Hole-in-One Insurance

How do you win?

You get a hole in one at Lakewood during a round of golf with at least one reputable witness. This could be the hardest part. Not the hole in one, but the reputable witness.

How do I get paid?

Everyone that is signed up for Hole-in-One insurance will be billed \$10. This collected money will be rolled into your credit book on your account to be used in the bar or the proshop.

We had 3 hole in one's last year and not one of them had insurance. I saw 2 of them sneaking away so they did not have to buy drinks and the other was hit with a \$250 bar bill.

Call the proshop to sign up.

Example: At my last club we had 160 members signed up for the insurance. 3 to 4 times per year we would have a hole-in-one and these members received \$1600 to their account. You can buy a lot of drinks for \$1600.
