





Greens & Grounds - Betty Hand
Greens and Grounds are focused on three main objectives, having the golf course prepared for play on a daily basis, finding the right Superintendent for Lakewoo, and completing projects, especially those that are supporting our greens transition. We are actively negotiating with a candidate at this time so more to come soon on that front. Some of the G & G projects completed in March include repairing low waterlogged spots on the maintenance access road, continuing to make repairs to the maintenance buildings, trimming low hanging limbs, removing an ill-placed pine tree by the 12<sup>th</sup> green, shoring up a couple of ground erosion issues, and having Diver Kyle give us a "good to go" on the irrigation pump in-take located in Lake Tullahoma. A few active spring projects that are underway include repairing the practice putting green, leveling and seeding the low spots on the greens around the course, and starting up the irrigation system. And kudos to all the folks, Noah, the Grounds staff, the Workhorses and the G & G Committee, for making this happen!



As you may have seen around the course we have received the newly leased John Deere equipment which is here just in time for the spring turf growing season! And while this agreement includes equipment maintenance repair through a John Deere technician, we do still use some aged equipment that needs repairs from time to time. For that reason we are looking at the possibility of hiring either a part-time or on-call mechanic. If you know someone that you believe might be a good candidate please forward that information to myself or the Business Office.

#### Section 7. Golf Course Rules

- 1. General Golf Course Rules
- I. Players having one or more holes open in front of them must defer to faster players.
- J. Members and their guest must wear proper golfing attire. Halter tops, tank tops, tee shirts, sports jerseys, blue jeans\* and "cut-offs" are not considered proper attire. Men's shirts must have a collar. \*Blue jeans (without rips, holes, tears) may be worn seasonally outside of Daylight Savings Time.
- K. Groups of more than four players will be permitted only at the discretion of the Pro or after 5:00pm on weekends.






