An update of the golf course: Brutal Brutal Brutal

The last few weeks have been a superintendent's nightmare as we've had very little rain and very high daytime and nighttime temperatures. When the nighttime temperatures do not recede, it doesn't allow the turf to breathe at night or have any recovery time. This is not what the bentgrass needs to survive through the Tennessee summers. The ideal weather for bentgrass would be highs in the low 80's and lows in the 50's, allowing it to thrive here.

The maintenance team has been working through this extreme heat and somewhat of a drought to keep the course the best that we can. We've had some ups and downs this season trying to keep staff, but seem to be turning a corner in a positive direction. Please bear with us as we diligently try to navigate our way through this difficult time and keep Lakewood in the best condition possible. Along with the weather and staffing issues, we've had our share of equipment breakdowns as well. Hopefully our new fleet will still be arriving this fall. I've been told that we're on schedule for September-October delivery.

We will be aerifying the greens the Tuesday and Wednesday after Labor Day: September 6th and 7th. We'll be using a 5/8" hollow tine on the greens this year. This means a little bigger hole and more topdressing sand to help in the recovery of the greens from this necessary process. We've tried to "vent" the greens a little more this year to help improve the root zone and water infiltration to improve the overall putting surface. When I've had staff available, they've been able to do some plugging of the bad spots to help improve the greens in those areas.We'll continue to do so this late summer and early fall as much as we can.

I was able to get away for the first time in a very long time and take a family vacation to Europe. My wife's family, 14 of us in total, took a Viking River Cruise up the Rhine River and it was absolutely amazing. I highly recommend this to anyone looking to try a river cruise. I'd like to say a big thank you to my staff, Joe Galbreath, and Noah Risner for doing everything in their power to keep things in shape in my absence.


