The 2021 year was a positive one for Lakewood Country Club. Membership increased and more outside events started to return. Hopefully the trend will continue into 2022.

Below are the Financial changes from November to December 2021.

Income:

Membership Fees:	Increased 138 %
Hospitality Sales:	Increased 45%
Pro Sales:	Increased 28%
Total Revenue:	Increased 97%

Expenses:

Cost of Food:	Increased 110%
Golf and Grounds:	Decreased 20%
Hospitality:	Increased 35%
Clubhouse:	No Change 0%
Pro Shop:	Increased 49%
Administrative:	Increased 18%
Total Expenses	Increased 12%

Note: The increase in Membership dues occurred because we have 14 memberships who pay annually. And, the increase in Hospitality Sales and COGS was the result of Christmas Parties returning to Lakewood.

Greens & Grounds - Dave Hamann & Tommy Dennis

Just a quick update of what's going on this winter with the golf course. We've been doing quite a bit of inside work this winter due to inclement weather. The guys seem to appreciate being able to work in the shop versus the cold winter weather.

We've been making new tee markers for the upcoming year from some cedar trees that blew down in one of the storms. They've also made new boxes for the par 3 tees to hold the green sand for divots. We'll begin maintenance and rebuilding some of our mowing equipment for the upcoming season.

We'll begin some tree removal from around the golf course soon. The trees that we'll be removing are ones that are due damage or preventing growth on our greens. Some others are along the right side of 10 fairway that have taken some of that fairway over the years and we're going to get back.

We are also looking to hire a contractor for sod work on some of our greens, however in the meantime we've begun taking plugs from the putting green to start repairing some areas on the greens. I'm bringing in someone to look at our collar dams on many of our greens and lower them to allow water to be able to get off and away from the greens. These dams have built up over the years from aerification and top dressing the greens. This will allow the greens to be much healthier in the future.

Looking forward to the 2022 golf season and improving the overall playing surfaces at Lakewood.

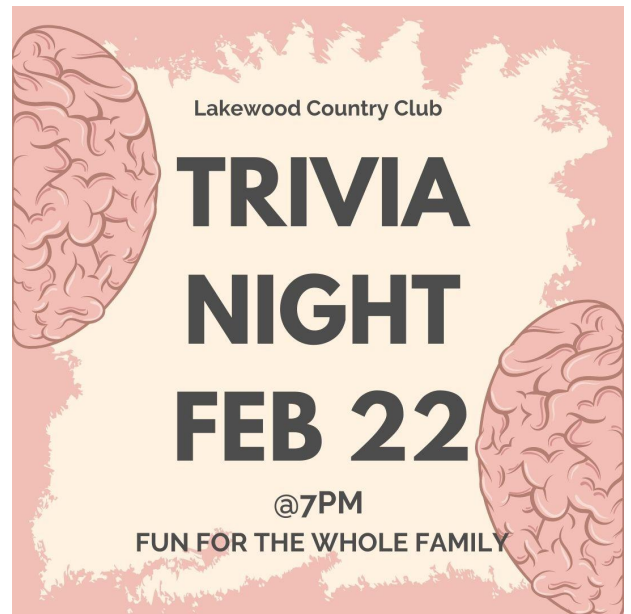
