The Greens and Grounds Committee is the advisory body for the upkeep and maintenance of the clubhouse grounds, the golf course and other golf related property and shall establish rules for the use of golf carts and the closing of the course because of weather conditions. With that in mind as you might have seen we recently provided rules regarding cart path only restrictions, on holes #1, #2, #6, #10 and #11 during the winter months to limit traffic on these fairways at a time when the ground tends to stay wet and the turf is not growing or healing from cart use. Also, as a standard year-around rule, with the exception of parking on the cart path, carts should not be parked or driven within 50 yards from the greens in all directions.

Current committee activities include: 1) a decision to remove the maple tree in front of the #5 green per earlier USGA advisement replacing the roots and rocks with a playable turf area, 2) obtaining a quote to repair the maintenance access road that is often partially underwater, 3) long overdue repairs on the equipment maintenance buildings, 4) preparations for removing tree stumps around the course and 5) investigating ways to address the #6 creek erosion issues to improve appearance, playability and natural flow of the stream.

You do not have to be a member of the Greens and Grounds Committee to contribute. You can sign-up to assist with the Workhouse team, share your thoughts and expertise to initiatives being planned and be someone that actively follows the rules and asks the same of their playing partners.

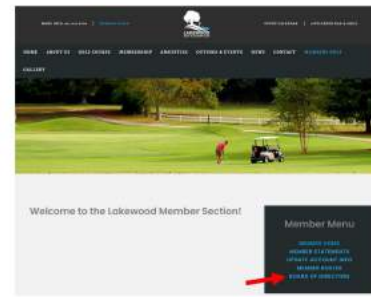

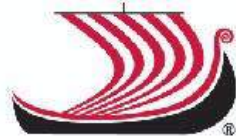
