We have a 3 part plan for our greens.

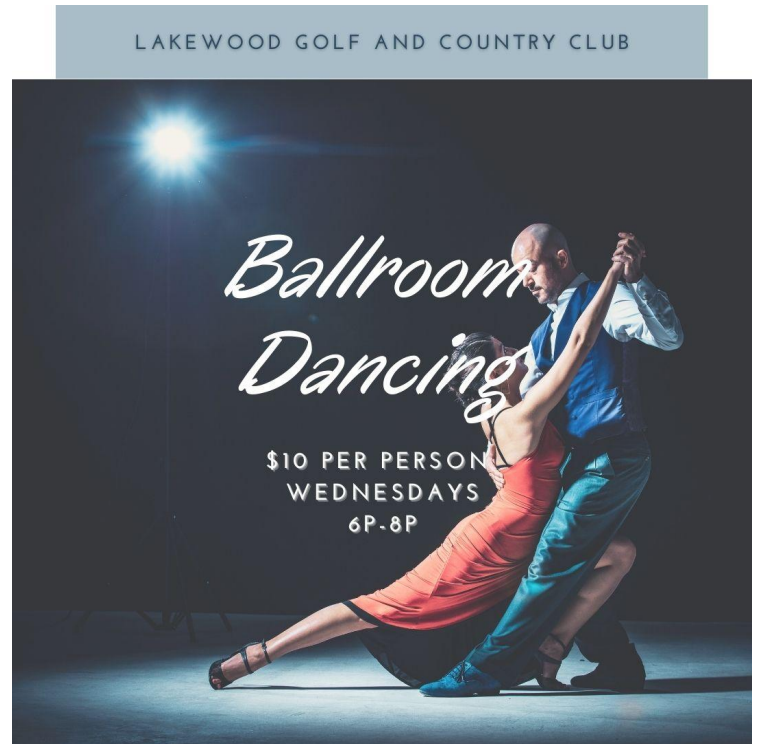
1. Fix the fringe dams around the greens.
