We have been talking about and preparing for the new TifEagle Bermuda greens for so long and it's finally happening. On Tuesday June 6th and Wednesday June 7th we will be sprigging (planting) the Bermuda turf. The Bermuda sprigs will be spread over the greens by Lakewood members, rolled in, top dressed and watered repeatedly along with fertility applications until there is visible active growth. When there is sufficient turf growth, mowing will commence!

Greens & Grounds -Betty Hand

There is a controversial issue that the Greens and Grounds Committee is struggling with and that's whether to cut down the tree that is on the left front of the #7 green. On one side, it is a beautiful massive tree that some say is part of our logo. It's obviously been there many years, and for some has become a long-standing Lakewood symbol. On the other side, Bermuda greens need 8–10 hours of sunlight year around to provide a good putting surface. There is also concern that it will make the hole play too easy. Recognizing this Trevor, our superintendent and Chad, our greens conversion private contractor who are trying to deliver the best greens possible, have noted that the front part of the #7 green gets too much shade and that the tree roots are leaching water and fertility from the green. Trimming the tree up and or topping it would not address the concern. The Greens and Grounds Committee (Betty Hand, Greg Gates, Trent McNabb, Dan Merz, Noland Gomez, Noah Risner, James McCord, Tommy Dennis, Clay Uselton, Michele Shaver, Kemp Brooks, Rob Scherer) would like to hear from you. 














Social - Trent McNabb (and Katie)

Finance - Mike Melton



In April we had a profit of \$66,939 which was much better then the budgeted loss of \$7,289. However \$31,000 of the \$66,939 was the result of billing out the balance of the second assessment to member accounts.

The profit from the bar and restaurant for April was \$15,155 a big improvement from the lost they had last month.

Expenses for the month of April were under budget by \$186.

To date we have received \$165,000 from the assessment. We still have a few members that need to pay the second \$500. As far as expenses for the greens renovation go we have spent \$27,521 for the tarps that will cover the greens and a down payment of \$15,000 for the sprigs.
