Hopefully this will be the last summer we have to deal with that issue. The greens committee met the last week of August and here is a list of items discussed.

- 1. Next meeting is September 15 at 4:00PM
- 2. Between September 6 23, Dave and his guys will repair greens with plugs, sod, sand and seed. Might do aerification. Need all holes filled in.
- 3. Dave needs to get us the price of a pallet of bent grass sod
- 4. Need to plan for switching to TifEagle next year. Dates, cost, ect. Need by the end of September. (Dave)
- 5. Fraze mowing will take place at time of killing the greens in June
- 6. Tree trimming, tree removal, tree planting will be Fall/Winter projects. Need to form a tree committee.
- 7. The areas where we lost trees to the tornados that need to be sodded will take place next summer.
- 8. Membership meeting in September to talk about moving to TifEagle
- 9. Bridge assessment in October. We'll pick a date and ride the course and come up with a plan for the bridges.
- 10. Goose grass/weed control has got to be fixed
