Thank you to all of the members and staff for their warm welcome to LGCC! I am settling into my position here and have enjoyed getting to know everyone.


We have been working out problems with the irrigation system in order to better manage the overall playing conditions of the golf course. There have been improvements with the help of Smith Turf & Irrigation.

In addition, I chose not to Fall aerify the greens due to poor root structure and continued high temperatures. I've applied some foliar and granular products to build a healthier root and turf plant to the greens. We will continue this practice next Spring and Fall in 2020.

We are looking forward to finishing off the season with the Fall Ramble and Baits Cup in the next two weeks. Thank you for all of the continued support and patience as we are building a maintenance team to improve the quality of LGCC.
