Greens and Grounds has been on overdrive for the past month! The critical irrigation issues were addressed allowing for a successful sprigging of the front nine fairways. The Greens and Grounds crew combined efforts with the Workhorse group to clean up brush around the course which was especially needed to support the Out-Of-Bounds initiative that was completed. Posts were adjusted or added as needed to provide a clear line of sight. We now have a designated chipping green with holes and flags as well as a flag in the simulated green toward the road. The fairway boundaries on holes 8 and 16 were adjusted for improved playability. Modifications were made at the 8th tee box to open up the view and for ease of play. Carts On Path stenciling was added to provide guidance on where carts should be returning to the cart path prior to driving to the greens to improve and maintain the approach turf, and the yardage circles on the path have been refreshed. A huge thank you to all those that participated in the Greens Picking Party where we learned how to recognize and remove goosegrass from the greens! (see below)

On another note, if you have suggestions for improvements around the golf course and or grounds please direct those in writing to me or one of the Greens and Grounds Committee members. The G & G Committee maintains a list of improvement projects that we discuss once a month and it's far more productive and has the best chance of being considered if it comes through this group versus undocumented one-off conversations.

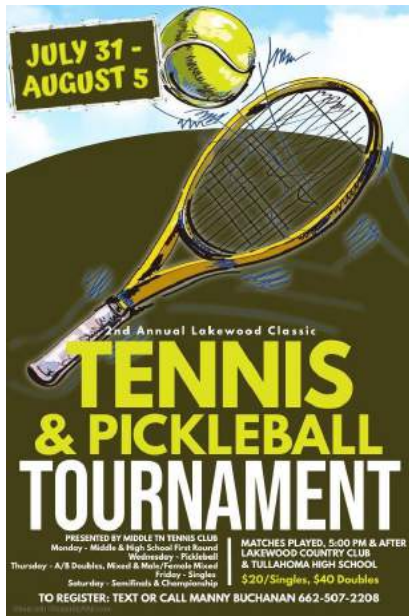

In June we had a loss of \$36,218, however this was much better than the budgeted loss of \$58,048.

All departments with the exception of Greens and Grounds came in under budget for June.

The Restaurant and Bar reversed the loss from last month with a \$8,152 profit for June.

Year to Date we have spent \$109,946 of the \$173,000 collected for the assessment. (We still have to pay for the sprigs that have been spread on the front fairways. Estimated cost is \$50,000)

NEW LAKEWOOD TEE MARKERS (HELP NEEDED)

Noah & Alice Risner have a friend who does this kind of work and has made an extremely exciting offer to make these tee markers for us and have them ready by (hopefully) September 1. The Lakewood Ladies Golf Association started this project and are committed to partially fund.

We are looking to raise more so that we can complete it.

The sample shown at left is unfinished. The larger piece that says LAKEWOOD will be the tee marker color (i.e. Black, White, Gold, Red, Orange). The smaller piece (tree) will be green and will be mounted on top to give a dimensional look.

(Note: We will also be changing the silver tees to orange so as to be more visible since most are in the fairways)

Each tee marker will cost \$22 / \$44 per tee box per hole. We need a total of 200 (5 tee boxes x 2 for each tee x 18 holes plus an additional 20 to have on hand). If you are interested in purchasing a hole, a tee box set, or just giving a donation, we would appreciate your help. Please consider being a part in helping to make Lakewood shine as we reopen!

This sample shows 2 pieces that have not been powder coated. The larger piece with LAKEWOOD on it will be the color of the tee (black, white, gold, red or orange) and the smaller piece will be attached on top of that and will be powder coated green.



This is what the completed tee marker would look like. 3 dimensional with the LAKEWOOD part being the tee color and the overlay of the tree green.
