Other than constantly blowing and removing endless trailer loads of leaves from the golf course, Greens and Grounds has been working with the Finance Committee on our budget as well as finalizing our Tree Management Plan.

In terms of the Greens and Grounds budget, we have three key financial priorities that can't be fully met by the standard operating budget: #1 - the verticut reels @ \$20k, which are essential to maintaining our new TifEagle greens, #2 - some 40-50 replacement irrigation heads @ \$500 each, as we have a number that are broken, and #3 - a \$10k equipment lift that will improve productivity by saving valuable time and ease daily equipment repair and maintenance.

Some of the irrigation heads are in the budget but the verticut reels and equipment lift are beyond what can be funded as standard operating cost. With that said, we are anticipating that the monies for the verticut reels are being allocated and we hope to raise the funds for the equipment lift, impart thanks to generous member/group donations. All additional contributions welcome!

In terms of the Tree Management Plan, we now have the location, species and availability of trees selected with estimated cost. At this time this initiative will not be funded in the Lakewood budget and is totally dependent on donations. Per our plan the cost to implement, in total, is in the range of \$7.5k and \$9.5k, depending on the size of trees we purchase. In some cases, there is only one size available, in other species we may have an option of purchasing a larger caliber tree, hence the cost differential. The good news being that with a plan in place we can proceed with purchasing trees and planting as funds become available. The immediate goal is to start the planting process over this winter.


