## Greens & Grounds - Betty Hand



As our long-term members are aware, Lakewood has lost or removed a number of trees from the golf course over the years. The Greens and Grounds Committee is in the process of developing a tree management plan. The initial focus is on the front nine, where the loss of trees has impacted hole definition and playability. For example, between the left side of hole #1 and the driving range, between holes 4, 5 and 6 fairways, and between holes 8 and 9 fairways. In addition to our superintendent Trevor Vestal, we are reaching out to professional experts for input into the appropriate species of trees for a golf course in our region of the country. The goal is to have a living document that can provide guidance for years to come as our golf course's needs and conditions change. 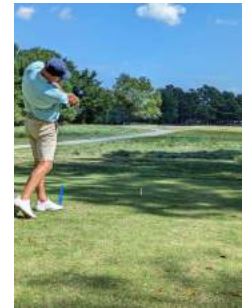
