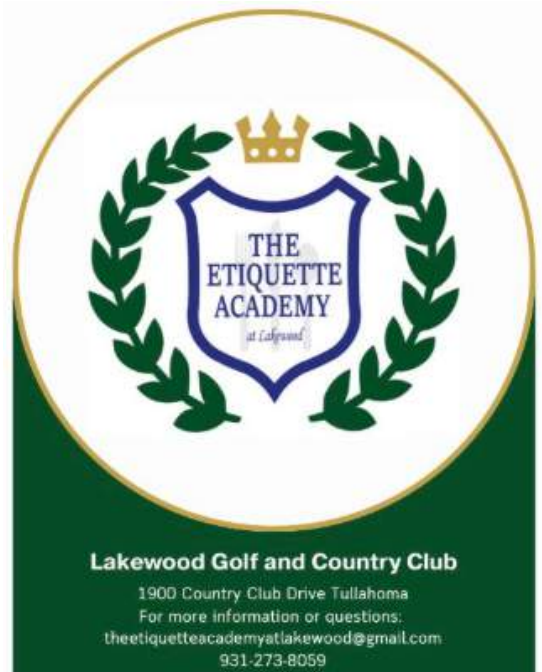

MASTERING THE GREEN - GOLF & PRO SHOP



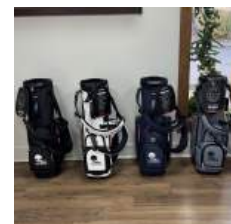
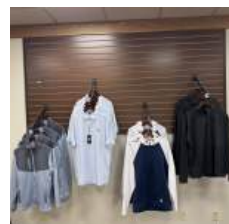
