We're excited to share Lakewood's new official logo as we head into our 100th year. This design was created to be timeless, meaningful, and uniquely ours — with every element tied directly to Lakewood's identity, history, and setting.

We wanted something that truly represents our club — not just a golf logo, but a mark that reflects our name and the place we call home. The pine cone represents the “wood” in Lakewood and the natural beauty that surrounds our course. Inside the pine cone is the silhouette of Lake Tullahoma, bringing in the “lake” and grounding the design in something that is distinctly local.

There's also a subtle detail you may notice the more you look at it — the lake shape naturally forms an “L,” giving a quiet nod to Lakewood within the design itself.

You'll see a few versions of the logo around the club. The “100” mark will help celebrate our centennial throughout 2026, the “1926” version honors our founding year, and the pine cone alone will serve as a clean, recognizable symbol for apparel, signage, and everyday use.

We're proud of how it came together and feel like it tells the Lakewood story in a simple, authentic way. We're excited to roll it out and carry it forward into our next 100 years.





## WELCOME TO LAKEWOOD

Following months of exploration, talking with golf club-based Point of Sale (POS) system providers and viewing numerous demonstrations, under Trent's initiative and leadership, the Board led POS Replacement Team has selected Jonas Synergy to replace our current system. The team that included board members as well as the club managers investigated seven golf club POS systems.

While Synergy is one of Jonus' latest offerings, Jonus was founded in 1990 and has over 2,300 clubs in 20 countries worldwide with membership ranging from 20 to 20,000. Synergy will not only replace Club Prophet functionality but will provide a suite of offerings that includes POS for retail/food & beverage, inventory, tee time management, event management, financials, website and email support and a membership mobile app, all under one umbrella.

One of the most important aspects of the implementation will be ensuring that we have accurate data in Club Prophet that will be the basis for our new POS system database. With that in mind, we are asking that you assist us in validating the database. For example, if you have had changes in home address, phone number, marriages, births and or dependents, this would be a great time to let us know. **Hello Gentleman,**

We are excited to announce the upcoming 2026 Lakewood Golf and Country Club Men's Member Guest Tournament scheduled for **June 25<sup>th</sup> through 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026**.

We've wrapped up our initial planning meetings, and it's time to begin building the field. All can expect a similar format as we continue with the expanded multi-day tournament introduced in 2025.

Currently, we are asking members to simply let us know if you **plan to play this year** so we can begin organizing the field and working through priority and waitlist placements. To be clear, this is for all members and any member can register. This includes members that have not been in tournament or waitlist before.

The entry fee for this year's event will be **\$1,200 per team**. For those signing up, this will go on your March bill. To secure your spot, **all teams must be paid by April 30<sup>th</sup>**. Any team not paid by this date will be moved to the waitlist.

Please note all players must have an active GHIN handicap to play in the Member Guest

- **Cancellations after June 1 - No refund**

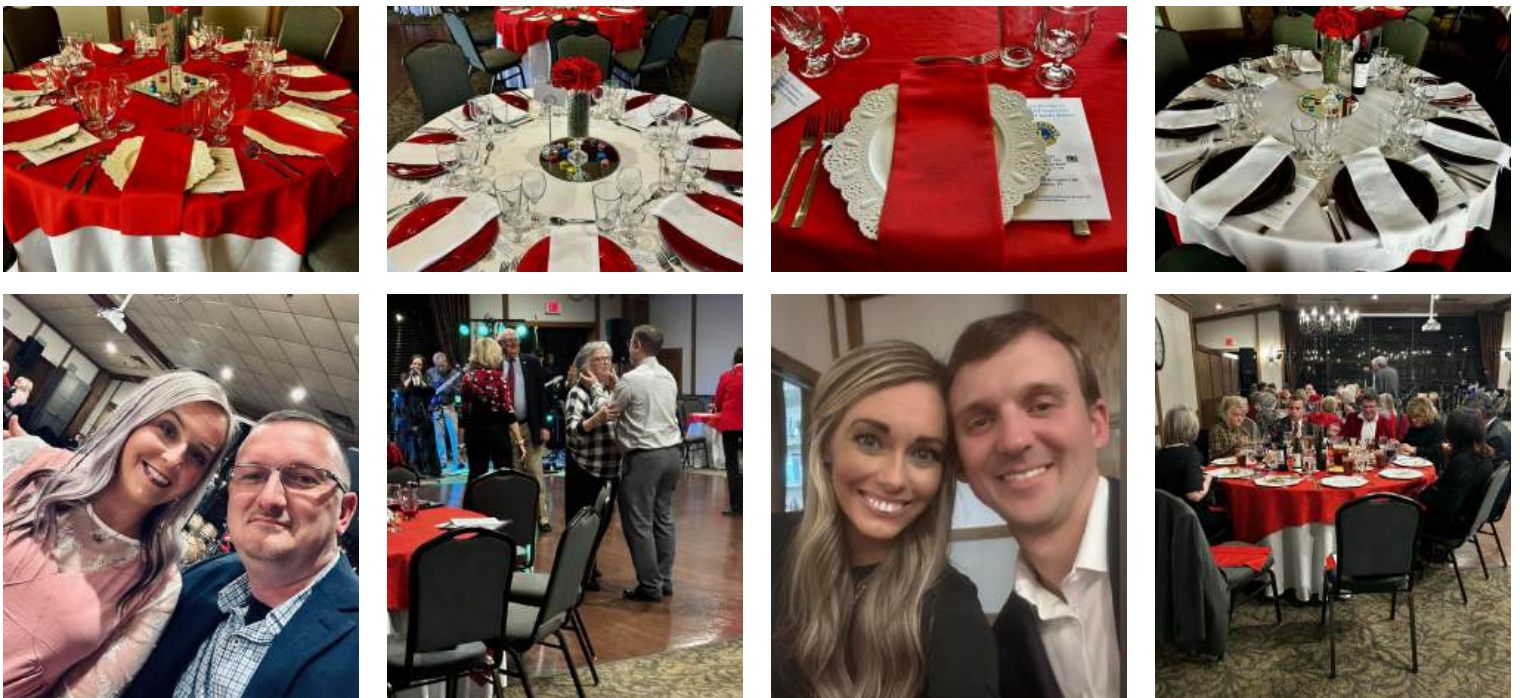
